The NAARS recognizes the eight legitimate occupants of the throne of the Kingdom of Araucania and Patagonia: Orelie-Antoine de Tounens (1825-1878) as Orelie-Antoine I, Achille Laviarde (1841-1902) as Achille I, Antoine-Hippolyte Cros (1833-1903) as Antoine II, Laura-Therese Cros (1856-1916) as Laura-Therese I, Jacques Alexandre Antoine Bernard (1880-1952) as Antoine III, Philippe Paul Alexandre Henry Boiry (1927-2014) as Philippe I, Jean-Michel Parasiliti di Para (1942-2017) as Antoine IV, and Frédéric Nicholas Jacques Luz (b. 1964) as Frédéric I.

Membership in the NAARS is restricted to people who affirm the above-stated principles.
